1. List family members (2 adults and all minors) residing in one household; membership in a Canadian orienteering club/association is required for ALL participants in Yukon Orienteering events and programs. YOA membership fees include insurance and membership in Orienteering Canada.
2. For each member, decide if you want to **pre-pay for events** for big savings and convenience; this covers one map and SI card for the member for every Wednesday night event including Yukon Championships. Otherwise, you may pay for each event individually at \$10/map.

YUKON ORIENTEERING ASSOCIATION LIABILITY RELEASE AND WAIVER FORM

I/We, _____, of the Yukon Territory, hereby agree, acknowledge and confirm that:

1. This Release is given in consideration of my/our being allowed to participate in any way in the orienteering services provided by Orienteering Canada and/or the Yukon Orienteering Association (referred to collectively as the "Orienteering Group").
2. I/We acknowledge and fully understand that orienteering is an activity where, as participants, I/we will travel by foot or other means in areas that may contain harsh terrain or wildlife, and will be exposed to the elements. The orienteering activities involve some risk of serious injury, including permanent disability or death, and severe personal and/or economic losses which result not only from the participants' own actions, inactions or negligence but the action, inaction or negligence of others. Further, there may be unanticipated or unexpected risks which arise during such activities.
3. I/We, as participants and, where applicable, as parents or guardians of participants, assume all of the risks of injury to ourselves, our children or our property that may be sustained in connection with the orienteering activities provided by the Orienteering Group and accept personal responsibility for the damages following such injury, permanent disability or death.
4. I/We, as participants and, where applicable, as parents or guardians of participants, release, waive, discharge and covenant not to sue the Orienteering Group, its affiliated clubs and organizations, their respective administrators, directors, agents, coaches and other employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers and owners and lessors of the land upon which the orienteering activities are provided (the "Releasees") and from any and all liability to me, my heirs, next of kin, administrators and assigns for any and all claims, demands, actions and causes of action of any sort for losses or damages on account of injury, including death or damages to property, caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by negligence of the Releasees or any other fault.
5. My/Our participation in the orienteering activities is voluntary.
