YOA – Copper Ridge Event – August 23, 2023

The orienteering event that took place on the southwest corner of Copper Ridge on August 23 was a great success. The temperature was very warm, especially for late August, but the forest was quite enjoyable, with very few mosquitoes and black flies. Participants could appreciate that a number of trees had fallen during the late-July thunderstorm, and this affected the speed of several participants on technical portions of the advanced and expert courses. Fortunately, all trails had been recently maintained and no fallen trees impacted the intermediate and novice courses.

At course closure, at 8:30 pm, there had been a total of 56 registrations. This included 8 participants on the novice Course, 23 on the intermediate course, 13 on the advanced course, and 12 on the expert course.

On the expert course (more than 3.4 km) Colin Abbott was the fastest runner, with an Olympic time of 29 min 16 sec, followed by Forest Pearson (34 min 45 sec) and Leif Blake (37 min 47 sec). On the advanced course, Carl Turcotte (junior, 42 min 14 sec) made it just before Philippa McNeil (44 min 22 sec) and Phineas Pearson completed the podium (junior, 58 min 7 sec). On the intermediate course, Daniel Dreiseitl was the fastest participant (37 min 20 sec), followed by Declan Wise (junior, 37 min 57 sec), and Ian Turcotte (junior, 43 min, 5 sec). Finally, on the novice course Nelia Turcotte (junior, 32 min 25 sec) was first to complete the 2.5 km course, then Hugo Horton (junior) and Erin Neufeld came second with a time of 38 min 38 sec, and the third position went to Coralie (junior), Opal (junior) and Gina Anderson (43 min 16 seconds).

The organizers would like to thank all participants for their enthusiasm and feedback. Great discussions took place as the sun was setting behind Haeckle Hill.
